 (ii) Where the candidate secures the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such papers in which he has obtained at least 25% marks.
 (iii) For reckoning 50% of the papers at the M.A. Previous Exam., Practicals will be included and one Practical will be counted as one paper.
 (iv) If the number of the papers prescribed for the previous examination is an odd number, it shall be increased by one for the purpose of reckoning 50% of the papers
