- Notes — 1. *Classification : First Division 60%, Second Division 48% and Pass 36% in the total aggregate.
2. For a pass, a candidate is required to obtain at least 25% marks in each theory paper and 36% marks in the total aggregate at the Previous & Final Examinations separately as well as 36% marks in each practicals separately wherever prescribed.
3. Circle around the marks denotes deficiency in the Paper/Total.
4. (a) Ord. 212—A candidate who failed at the M.A. Previous examination, but passed in at least 50% papers prescribed for the exam. in accordance with the rules given below in clause No. (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall be eligible to re-appear in the failing paper(s) of Previous Examination along with the Final Year Examination
- Where the candidate fails to secure the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such paper in which he has obtained at least 36% marks
 - Where the candidate secure the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers, he shall be deemed to have passed in each such paper in which he has obtained at least 25% marks.
 - For reckoning 50% of the papers at the M.A. (Previous) Examination, Practical will be included and one practical will be counted as one paper.
 - If the number of the papers prescribed for the previous examination is in odd number, it shall be increased by one or the purpose of reckoning 50% of the papers.
- (b) Ord. 212-A—A candidate who has failed at the M.A. (Final) Examination but has passed in at least 50% of the papers obtaining 36% marks in each paper prescribed for the examination in accordance with the rules given below shall be deemed to be exempted from re-appearing in a subsequent year in the papers in which he has passed :
- Where the candidate fails to secure the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for a pass in the aggregate of all the papers he shall be deemed to have passed in each such papers in which he has secured at least 36% marks.
